- Provide a curriculum that is broad, balanced and meets the individual learning needs of each child
- Notify families of any change in circumstances that may affect their child

The **family** will:

- Make sure that their child attends regularly and provide a verbal or written explanation if their child is absent from school
- Ensure that their child is well enough to attend school
- Attend school events and meetings when possible
- Notify the school of any change of circumstances that may affect their child
- Avoid, where possible, taking holidays during term time. There is a county wide clarified policy in place, an advisory leaflet will be provided. All absence from school has a detrimental effect on learning.
- Actively support school policies and guidelines for behaviour
- Support their child in homework and other opportunities for home-learning

The **learner** will:

- Bring all the equipment needed every day
- Behave in a responsible way to enable effective learning to take place
- Perform to the best of their ability at all times
- Be on time for all lessons
- Be polite and helpful to others
- Wear the agreed school uniform and have a tidy appearance
