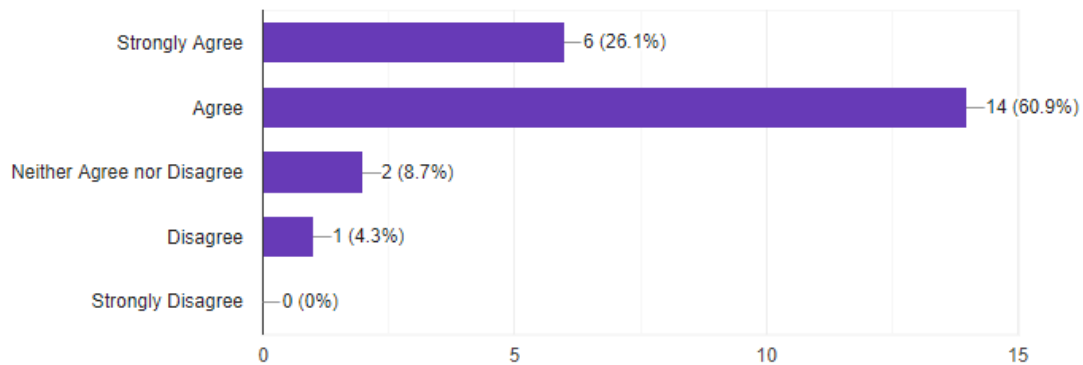
Summer Term 2021

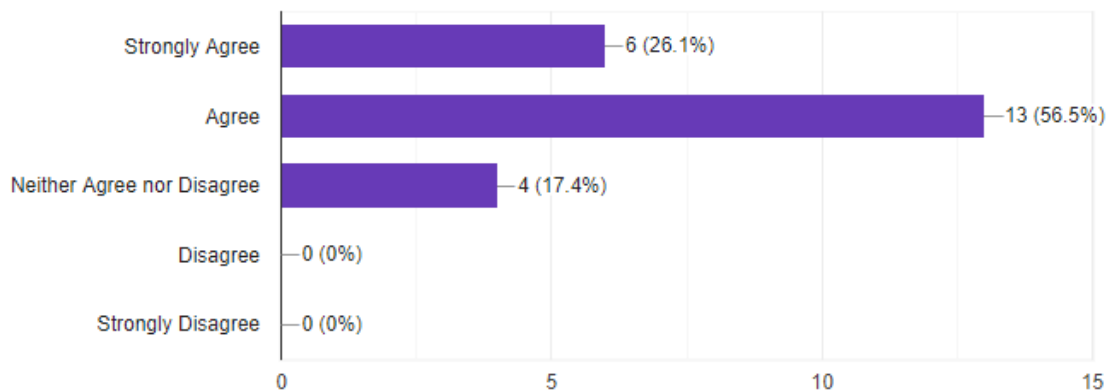
I understand the vision and focus for HSLC's careers programme

I understand HSLC's programme of careers education for my child(ren)

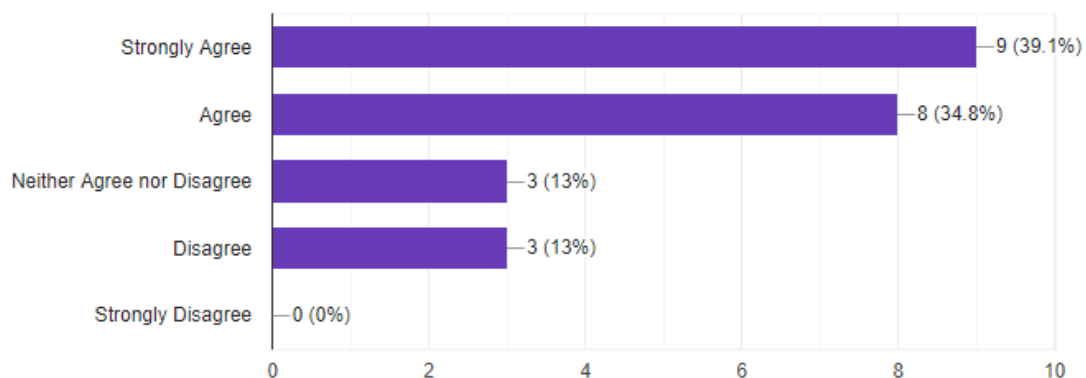

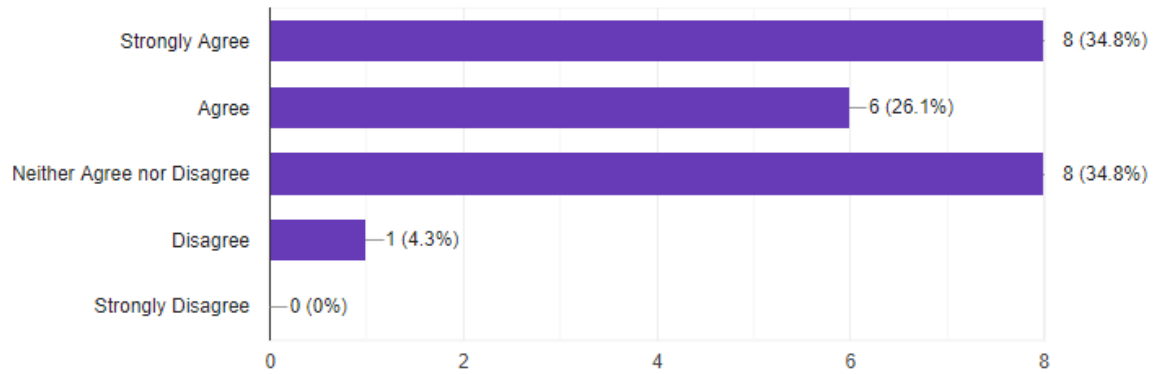
HSLC helps me to access labour market information and jobs and opportunities (including apprenticeships) locally and nationally

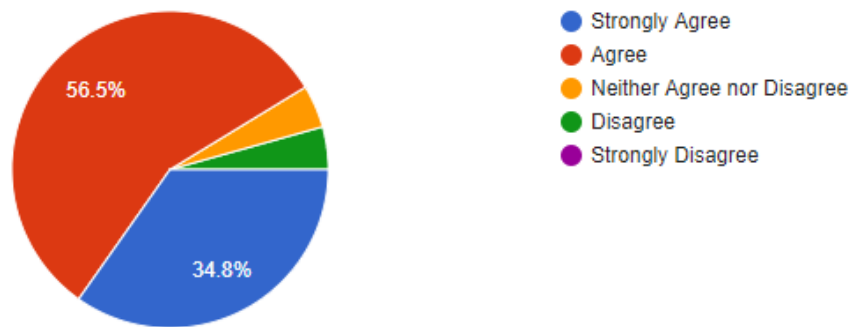
HSLC has helped me to understand the career pathways including option choices for my child after Year 11 (post 16 choices)

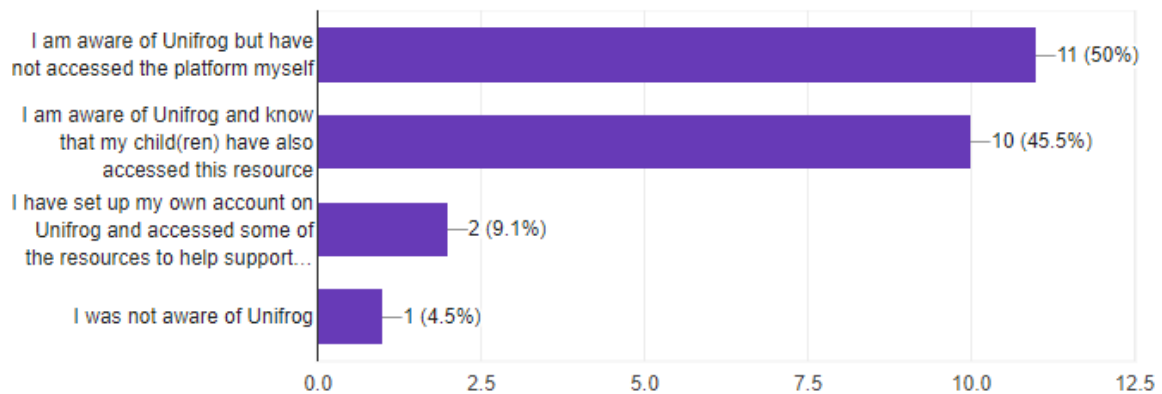

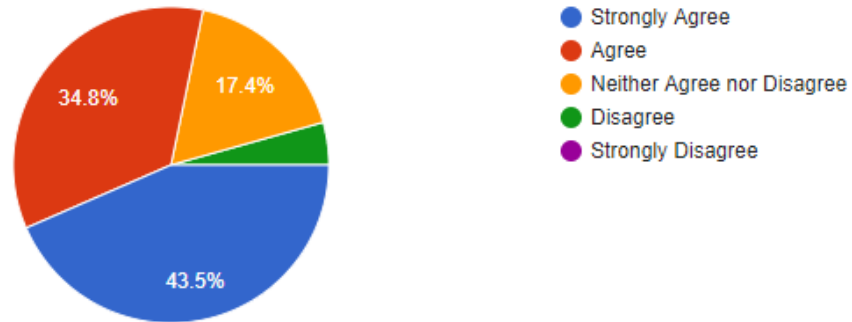

My child(ren) is/are well supported to make informed decisions at key decision points

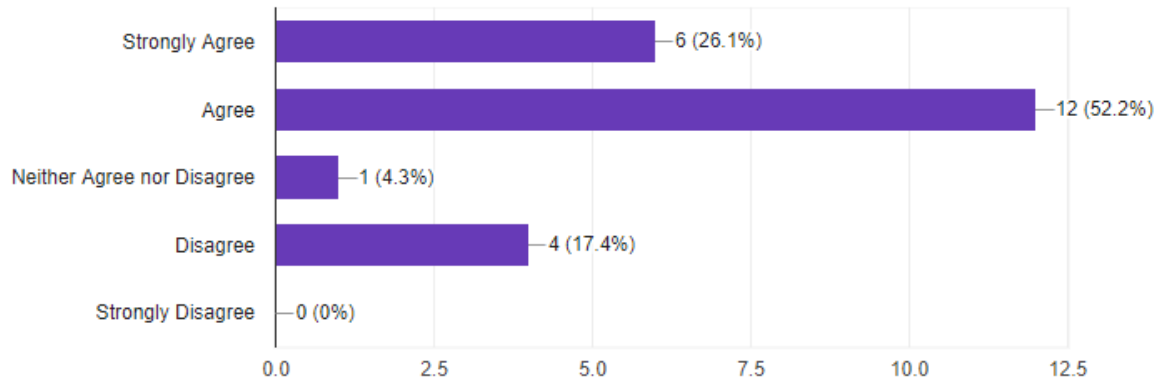

My child(ren) have developed key employability skills this year (i.e. listening, presenting, problem solving, creativity, staying positive, aiming high, leadership, teamwork)

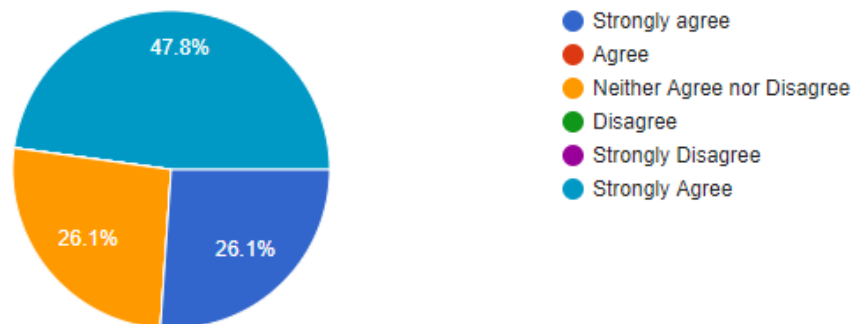
