

The creative industries offer a wide range of career opportunities across a multitude of subject specialisms. The aim of our Creative Programme is to ensure our students are provided with the information that will allow them to understand the exciting opportunities within the sector and receive all of the guidance and support needed to make a competitive application.



## **PROGRAMME CONTENT**

In discussion with programme participants, the content of the Creative Pathway is tailored to the interests and desires of the students as much as possible. Each half term students receive a dedicated session within school to focus on these key areas. In addition, optional afterschool sessions are organised for students to enrich the information they will receive. Sessions may take a wide variety of formats, including: presentations and workshops from current teachers, Google meetings with lead professionals or discussion-based learning. The content of these sessions may include areas such as:

- Career Guidance sessions
- My Path Opportunities to discuss career routes with past students in the industries
- Bespoke 1-2-1 sessions on personal statements, university applications and mock interview/audition workshops.
- Assistance with arranging appropriate work experience

In addition to these sessions, students will work in small groups or individually to present a project on their chosen sector, in cooperation with the whole school production. This could be costume design, lighting, set and many more. This will be presented to a panel of current senior staff and students will be given the chance to present findings, share opinions and receive questions too. Opportunities provided by the pathway will also include:

- Trip opportunities to visit local theatre productions, galleries and studios etc.
- University and course visits appropriate to chosen Creative sector.
- A wide range of practical workshops with industry professionals and Creative Pathway leads.
